UCF Graduate RAMP Fellowship

The UCF Graduate RAMP Fellowship is a competitive fellowship that is offered to the most outstanding undergraduate RAMP students who are accepted into UCF graduate programs. This fellowship award is worth about \$25,000 for a master's student and more than \$40,000 for a doctoral student. Award recipients are selected by the UCF Graduate Fellowship Committee. Most Graduate RAMP Fellowships will be offered beginning in fall semester. Fellowship students must be enrolled full-time in order to receive fellowship payments (9 graduate hours in fall and spring semesters; 6 graduate hours in summer semester). To apply for this fellowship, students must complete a Graduate RAMP Fellowship application at www.graduate.ucf.edu/formsnfiles/.

Duration of Award:

Maximum of two years of support (paid in fall and spring semesters) for master's students.

Maximum of four years of support (paid in fall and spring semesters) for doctoral students.

Fellowship Stipend:

\$10,000 per year (\$5,000 fall and \$5,000 spring).

Tuition Support:

UCF College of Graduate Studies pays the charges for your course hours during each year of the award. Local fees are not covered by this award.

This does not include the payment of local fees (health fee, athletic fee, building fee, etc.).

Health Insurance:

A UCF Student Health Insurance Policy through Aetna Student Health will be provided for your individual coverage for the duration of the award.

Criteria for Fellowship Selection:

- Available to students admitted into a UCF master's, specialist, or doctoral program. Preference will be given to those students entering UCF doctoral programs.
- Successful completion of the RAMP undergraduate program, including attendance at all RAMP program workshops and activities and participation in the Showcase of Undergraduate Research Excellence (SURE).
- Maintained 3.0 GPA at UCF (good academic standing).

- An outstanding GRE score relative to other students admitted into your graduate degree program.
- Statement of background and goals addressing your reason for pursuing graduate study.
- Letter of reference from your undergraduate RAMP faculty mentor.
- Letter of support from your graduate program indicating an interest in mentoring you and providing continuing financial support after the fellowship ends.

Fellowship Obligations:

- Maintain good academic standing and acceptable progress to degree in the graduate school and college.
- Participate in the Graduate Research Forum.
- Be involved in some aspects of the program's overall efforts to support RAMP undergraduate research, workshops and programming, mentoring, and general recruitment.

Fellowship Application Due Dates:

- Fall 2009 Admission: January 15, 2009.
- Spring 2010 Admission: October 1, 2009.
