Call for Proposals

Proposals of up to 1,000 words for paper, poster or roundtable sessions must be submitted with: a cover page that includes the title, conference theme, author(s), discipline, contact information, affiliated institutions, and type of session—**paper**, **poster** or **roundtable**.

Please submit proposals for research paper, poster, or roundtable sessions through education.ucf.edu/icde/survey by *December 2, 2016*. *Those accepted will be notified by January 13, 2017.*

Research Papers

Multiple sessions will occur concurrently. Presenters of paper sessions may be asked to present more than one time.

Posters

Doctoral students are encouraged to submit posters of their work in progress or completed work. Posters from academics who wish to provide case studies or other work on their professional and practice-led research will also be accepted.

Authors of posters accepted for the conference will display posters in print or digital format explaining their work in text, diagramme or other acceptable format.

Round Tables

Faculty wishing to engage colleagues in conversation surrounding their work in progress may submit to participate in a 30-minute roundtable discussion. The format will include 15-20 minutes for presenter to give overview of work with 10-15 minutes for Q&A.
